TICKETING

- Tickets are General Admission, please see above for home/visiting team seating locations
- Ticket prices are \$15 for Adults (ages 18-64); \$10 for Students (grades K-12) and Seniors (ages 65+)
 - Veterans and active military members may purchase tickets at \$10 each in person at the ticket trailer on day of game only. Valid military ID must be shown. One ticket per ID.
- Tickets for the NJSIAA High School Championship can be purchased in advance on <u>Ticketmaster.com</u>. Avoid waiting in ticket lines on game day and buy early.
- Ticket Sales and Will-Call: Located at ticket trailers outside MetLife Gate Opens at 9:00 am
- Barcodes for ticket scanning will appear on mobile tickets 8 hours prior to the event
- All guests over 34 inches tall must have their own ticket
- No re-entry: if you leave the Stadium, you will not be allowed to re-enter on the same event ticket
- All ticket holders should enter at the MetLife Stadium Gate

MOBILE TICKETING

- Your ticket must be displayed on your phone to enter the event (tickets will not be emailed / available to print)
- Please have your mobile ticket downloaded before you enter the security line
- How To Display Mobile Tickets On Your Phone:
 - Download the Ticketmaster App
 - o Find your mobile tickets in "My Events," and add them to your phone's wallet
 - Send Tickets directly to everyone else in your party before entering the Stadium
 - Display your mobile ticket at entry and you're in!

BAG POLICY

- Clear Bag Policy is NOT in effect for this event.
- All types of bags 12" x 12" x 12" or smaller in size are permitted.

TAILGATING & ALCOHOL POLICY

No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the premises (including parking lots), as they are strictly prohibited by the NJSIAA. Spectators are free to congregate in the parking lots to enjoy food and non-alcoholic beverages before and after playoff games at MetLife Stadium. All guests, however, must adhere to the Stadium's tailgating policies.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION: NJ TRANSIT rail service from Secaucus and Coach USA bus service from NYC Port Authority will not be operational for this event. NJ Transit Bus lines <u>160</u> and <u>703</u> service the Sports Complex and American Dream daily, please click on each line for the schedule.

RIDESHARE: Designated rideshare pick-up and drop-off location is in Lot E. **Be advised that rideshare surge pricing is often in effect after the event and larger crowds will result in longer than usual wait times for a car to arrive.** Please make sure your phone is charged and ready to go if you're planning to use one of these services!

SECURITY SCREENING

- All guests will be subject to a courteous screening via a walk-through metal detector at the Stadium gates
- Guests are required to place their cell phones, cameras, keys, and metal objects on the security table before walking through the metal detector
- Belts and jewelry do not need to be removed
- Guests should only bring items they absolutely need inside the Stadium
- Rules and Regulations in place at all participating school will be applied to this event at MetLife Stadium

PERMITTED ITEMS

- Non-professional still photography cameras with a lens that is 6" or less in length (case no larger than 12"x 12"x12")
- Empty reusable water bottles (plastic or aluminum) 20 oz. or smaller
- Food in a clear plastic baggie or wrapping
- Factory-sealed plastic water/soft-drink bottles
 20 oz. or less
- Small portable phone chargers, no larger than the cell phone itself

- Binoculars not contained in a case
- Handheld signs/banners smaller than 11"x17" (cannot be mounted to a pole or stick or be commercial)
- Battery operated clothing, as long as the battery is no larger than a cell phone and can be disconnected from clothing for security screening
- Small, collapsible (umbrella-style) strollers; note there are no stroller storage areas in the stadium
- Ponchos or raincoats (no umbrellas!)
- Medically necessary items (subject to inspection)

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- NO professional camera equipment, including DSLR cameras, any camera with a 6"+ lens, video cameras, monopods, tripods, GoPros, selfie sticks
- NO audio or recording equipment
- NO seat cushions of any size except for medical needs
- NO glass bottles, coolers, thermoses, or ice chests
- NO drones

- NO alcohol of any kind
- NO signs/banners larger than 11"x17"
- NO umbrellas, laser pointers, balls of any kind
- NO weapons, including firearms, knives and any item that may be used as a projectile
- NO animals except for a registered service animal
- NO displaying of indecent messages/language in any form on any printed material, including but not limited to, clothing, hats, signs, banners, flags, etc. Review our <u>Guest Code of Conduct</u>.
- Unauthorized soliciting, sampling, peddling of any product/food/drink is NOT permitted on the MetLife Sports Complex. Review the full policy in our A-Z Guide.

CONTACTLESS AND CASHLESS PAYMENTS ONLY

- MetLife Stadium operates cash-free. Only contactless payment options will be accepted within the Stadium.
- Pay with a debit or credit card (Visa is the preferred card of MetLife Stadium, Mastercard, AMEX, Discover)
- Mobile payment, including Apple Pay and Google Pay, is accepted
- Reverse ATMs are available onsite to load cash onto a prepaid Visa debit card valid for in-Stadium purchases
