Post Season Meeting Agenda Winter Track Tuesday March 18, 2025 10:00am

1. 2. Review of previous Post-Season Minutes- 2024 Post season minutes were distributed. Minutes were accepted by John Tonerio. Seconded John Schwarz. No comments on the previous year minutes.

Correspondence- Several emails were distributed to the group for review.

- Spikes at the bubble. Kyle Austin informed the group that it is because of the insurance that covers the facility that only covers 1/8 spikes to be worn. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THE SPIKES. ATHLETES CAN ONLY WEAR 1/8 SPIKES IN TOMS RIVER.
 - The facility is getting redone this spring and they are looking to add a second shot put circle inside the bubble.
 - Kyle Austin said that there were over 30,000 starts at the bubble this winter. They have gone with and will continue with two starting lines to minimize the use of the starting lines
 - One of the correspondences was about adding a weight throw to the MOC. The committee felt it shouldn't be added for next year.
 - Warm up areas for hurdlers was also discussed. Kyle Austin said he is looking into other ways for the hurdlers to warm up once the bubble gets redone.
 - It was discussed for the throw officials to be more audible when yelling out throws. Sean Dowd discussed that he will discuss with the officials for them to be more audible on the throws
 - One of the emails was about giving out more medals. The NJSIAA is trying to standardize the number of medals and so for the time being, the medals will remain the same.
 - Derryk Sellers will send an email to all the track coaches that we have an email for and inform them of the spike requirement at Toms River. Also the importance of the coaches to highlight their athletes before the races.
3. Review of the regular season (Positive / Negative)
 - Committee was pleased with the separation of Group 3 and 4 in the sectionals
 - Officials asked if possible to not have two long meets on Saturday/Sunday

- NJSIAA will try to group the sectionals together North 1, North 2, Central, South as best as possible.

 - The MOC will be at Ocean Breeze March 8, 2026
 - The tournament directors will look into the possibility of moving the 4x800 to later in the meet instead of the beginning
